## Find your ring size

## 1: Use an existing ring

Lay a ring that fits you well on top of the closest-sized circle below. The line should match the inside edges of your ring exactly. If you see any white space between the black line and the inside of the ring, move the ring to another size. If your ring falls between two sizes, we suggest choosing the larger size.

2: Measure with the ring ruler
Cut out the ruler below following the grey outline closely. Next, make a small cut along the dotted line and create a small slit in the paper. Wrap the ruler around your finger, and slide the thin end through the slit with the numbers facing up. Fasten it very tightly around the base of your finger, and your ring size will be shown along the dotted line.
